Abstract: Notwithstanding the widespread hype about cloud computing,

there is a lack of clarity on its prognosis, and ac cording to some critics,

even about its very nature and purpose. Even so, there is a palpable

need to identify the problems and possibilities ass ociated with cloud

computing that should be addressed by academia, ind ustry, as well as

society as a whole. In particular, there are a whole slew of research

issues that arise with cloud computing and call for original insights and

approaches. It is perhaps not out of place to suggest that a whole new

interdisciplinary science, which takes from several hitherto unconnected

fields of study, needs to be created and carefully studied. In this talk,

I present my own early vision of the shape that such a science of

cloud computing might take.

Abstract: Electric power grids around the world are rapidly evolving to

make more extensive use of communication technology . New intelligent

electronic devices are being developed and deployed in which

communications is becoming a ubiquitous and natural part of power systems

allowing new forms of collaborative behavior. An an alogy is often made

between the interconnection of personal computers m any decades ago

resulting in the rise of the Internet and what is h appening within the

power grid today. However, the power grid is a larg e and complex machine

with many aspects; it comprises a very broad set of topics. This

hour-long talk will begin with a review of power sy stems and focus upon

emerging communications capabilities within the power grid including:

metering and demand-response, distributed generation, fault detection

isolation and restoration, and a brief overview of emerging standards. We

will end with a discussion of more speculative inno vations that may

impact the smart grid further into the future.
